- **Check your e-mail daily.**
- **Get involved** – join clubs, organizations – run for student office – attend social events – **go and show your support at the basketball games. All home games are free to students with current SUSLA ID badges.**
- Your ID Badge is necessary to take advantage of your student activities, and to get grades and checks.
- Lost and Found is located in the University Police Office (located east of the Johnny Vance, Jr. Student Activity Center).
